



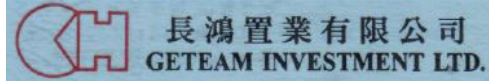

*Cancellation policy

Any cancellation before May 31, \$10 admin fee will be deducted. After May 31, no refund will be allowed.

Equipment

- Tables: Butterfly/ Double Fish Table/net Butterfly R 40+ 3* white balls

Eligibility

- All participants must be members in good standing of the BCTTA.
- Seeding in the draws is based on May Canadian ratings available at the time of the draw.
- The Tournament Committee may estimate the rating of any unrated player at any time during the tournament and remove that player from any event for which such a rating would make the player ineligible.

Format

- In Team events, each team consists of minimum 2 to maximum 3 players
- U4800 Team, top two players' rating points combined U4800 points U2200 Team, top two players' rating points combined U2200. Team event shall play in order: A v X, AC(AB) v XZ (XY), B v Y. The team that wins the first two matches is the winner. Teams play 2 best of 3 games in round robin group followed by knockout best 3 of 5 games depending on the number team of entries.
- All Singles have preliminary round robin in best 3 of 5 games to 11 points followed by single knockout.
- Events with less than 4 entries may be cancelled or combined with another event on discretion of the tournament committee.

Rules

- Current ITTF Laws of Table Tennis will be in effect.
- All rackets must be one side black and one side of any color with ITTF approved coverings.
- Tie-breaks in round-robins will be decided by the score of matches, games, points, only of those players involved in the tie.
- Only shorts and T-shirts are allowed to be worn during matches unless consent is given by the tournament referees. **Colour of playing shirt must not be white.**
- **Non-marking shoes must be worn in gym and street shoes are not allowed.**
- Players need to bring their own rackets and practice balls.
- **60+ singles is non-sanctioned.**

Umpiring

- In general, players will be required to umpire their own matches. Umpires will be provided for semi-finals & finals.
