ELIGIBILITY

- This tournament is open to BC Elementary School students of Grade 7 and under.
- All participants must be members in good standing of the BCTTA or students paying non-member fees for the tournament.

FORMAT

- All events shall be a single knockout with a preliminary round-robin group. A consolation round might be played if there is enough time.

RULES

- There is no school district restriction for Open Doubles.
- Current Laws of Table Tennis will be in effect.
- Only shorts and T-shirts are allowed to be worn during matches unless consent is given by the tournament referee.
- Non-marking shoes must be worn in the gym and street shoes are not allowed.
- **The color of the playing shirt should not be White.**
- Events with less than 3 entries may be canceled or combined with another event at the discretion of the tournament committee.
- Seeding for the individual events shall be based on Nov. TTCAN's ratings.
- All decisions by the Tournament Committee shall be final.
- All rackets must be on one side of black color and another side of different color with ITTF-approved coverings.

EQUIPMENT

- Players need to bring their own rackets and practice balls.
Tables and Nets: Butterfly., double Fish. Butterfly R40 3 Star balls

AWARDS

- Medals will be awarded to winners and runner-ups of each individual event.

Umpiring

- Generally, players will be required to umpire their own matches. Umpires will be provided at the semi-finals and finals.
