3 - Events and Format

2024 Canadian Para Championships

- Single events: Seating Classes (1-5)
- Single events: Standing Classes (6-11)

If two or more female athletes register for an event, separate men and women events will be organized. However, women may still be included in men events for more matches.

Stage 1: full round robin where possible
Stage 2: knock-out if more than 6 registered players

All matches will be best of five.

The date of draw - September 26th.

The Referee and Competition Manager have the right to modify any format based on the number of entries.

Finals will be part of Nova Open final tournament stage. Special presentations will be organized before and after finals. It will be streamed.

4- 2024 Nova Open

- Athletes with Canadian Ratings under 1800 - Class C
- Athletes with Canadian Ratings over 1800 - Open event.
- Expected number of matches 3 to 5.

5 - Training Camp

Coaches: Dejan Papic, one coach from Toronto area and provincial coaches who have at least 4 athletes at the camp.

Important Notes:

- The National Team list will be published after the Canadian ParaTT Championships
- The results count for Canadian rating system. New players will obtain a rating after the Championships' results are processed.

6 - Classification

Players who are not officially classified by the Para ITTF department may submit summary of medical documentation to dejan@ttcanada.ca before September 27th.

Documentation will lead to permission to participate at the ITTF events, also as rough guide on what to expect if a player decides to pursue official ITTF classification.

7 - Entry Eligibility

All players must be members in good standing of their respective Provincial/Territorial Table Tennis Association.

Players must be in good standing with TTCAN. Players are considered not in good standing if they have unpaid invoices to TTCAN. All debts must be paid by September 21st, 2024. Payments can be made by e-mail transfer to: melanie@ttcanada.ca

All participants must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents. Proof is required for new players.

13 - TTCAN Financial Contribution

Financial contribution toward the airfare to Toronto will be provided to the current National Team listed players as they appear at <https://ttcanada.ca/para-table-tennis-team-list/> only for out-of-province players. Players will be informed directly.

National Team players from Ontario, who reside more than 50 km from Mississauga, may receive a mileage subsidy based on TTCAN reimbursement rates.

All National Team players will receive full support for accommodation based on double room occupancy, if they participate at full activities (competitions + training camp).

Deadline to receive entries with paid fees and accommodation (if requested):

September 21st, 2024

Entries will not be accepted after the deadline or without fees or any outstanding debt with TTCAN.



Appendix A

Criteria for new TTCAN para ranking list

National Team para players will be listed as Team A and Team B

Team A criteria

Players should be selected based on the international ranking minimum requirement Top 10 at Americas ITTF Para ranking.

Players should be target-oriented and to maintain that status (Team A) following targets should be achieved within 12 months of the first appearance at the Team A list:

- Remain in the top 10 at ITTF America Para ranking.
- Participate in minimum (including international and Canadian sanctioned tournaments)
 - o 10 tournaments for players classes 8-11
 - o 6 tournaments for players classes 3-7
 - o 4 tournaments for players 1-2
- Provide annual training plan
- Committed to practice at least 3 times per week with TTCAN recognized coach willing to meet with TTCAN expert at least twice a year.
- Participate at Canadian Para Championships.

Team B criteria

- ITTF Para ranked player or top two within its class at Canadian Para Championships
- ITTF classified
- Participate in minimum (including international and Canadian sanctioned tournaments)
 - o 5 tournaments for players classes 8-11
 - o 3 tournaments for players classes 3-7
 - o 2 tournaments for players 1-2
- Participate at Canadian Para Championships.

Notes:

- TTCAN will offer support to all athletes and their coaches in the development of their annual training plans.
- Should the athletes be not able to have access sanctioned tournaments within a 200 km radius of their place of residence, they should notify TTCAN (dejan@ontariotabletennis.com) at the time of designing the annual training plan.
