

**Team Events & Fees (Non-sanctioned and no BCTTA Membership required):**

Div 1 – Unlimited rating	\$75/each team (Max. 12 teams)
Div 2 -- U3800	\$60/each team (Max. 24 teams)
Div 3 -- U1600	\$50/each team (Max. 24 teams)

**NOTE:**

- There are 3 team divisions. Each team has at least 2 to 3 players (no gender restriction). Div. 1, no rating limit. Div. 2, 2, or 3 players' rating combined U3800. Div.3, 2or 3 players' rating combined U1600. Team events are non-sanctioned with limited teams. No membership required. First come, first served.
- Team events Consolation rounds will be played if there is enough scheduling.

**NOTE:**

- Each player must register the same recorded name as his/her in the TTCAN rating system. Seeding will be based on TTCAN Oct Ranking.
- A USA player must report his/her US rating points.
- Each player can not register for more than one event if these events are scheduled at the same time.
- Cancellation must be submitted by email to [bcttatournament@gmail.com](mailto:bcttatournament@gmail.com) before Nov 5 at 3pm, and A \$20 administration fee will be applied. No refund will be allowed if the cancellation is after Nov 5.
- Cash awards are subject to change depending on the number of entries.
- The tournament committee reserves the right to combine or cancel the event if there are fewer than 4 entries.
- Each player is responsible for his/her practice ball.

### Eligibility

Open to all genders. The tournament committee will accept non-rated players during the matches. The committee has the right to remove the player from the registered event if he/she is overrated.

### Format

- Each team division will have a preliminary round-robin followed by knockout. 2 teams will advance. The consolation round might play if there is enough scheduling.
- Team format: Doubles (AC/BC v XZ/YZ; A v X; B v Y. All matches are best 2 of 3, each game is best 2 of 3 to 11 points.
  
- The single event shall have a preliminary round-robin followed by a knockout. The round-robin matches might play best 2 of 3 each game to 11 points depending on the number of entries followed by knockout best 3 of 5 games.

### Rules

**Current ITTF Laws of Table Tennis will be in effect.**

All rackets must be one side black and one side of any other color with ITTF-approved coverings.

Tie breaks in round robins will be decided by the score of matches, games, and points, only of those players involved in the tie.

Only shorts and T-shirts are allowed to be worn during matches unless consent is given by the tournament referees. **The color of the playing shirt must not be white.**

**Non-marking shoes must be worn in the gym and street shoes are not allowed.**

Players need to bring their own rackets and practice balls.

### Umpiring

- All players must volunteer to umpire all matches. Umpires will be provided at semi-finals and finals.
