Dear Athletes and Parents,

Happy New Year!

BCTTA is proud to host the 2025 National Seniors and Juniors Championships, July 18-20 (Seniors) and July 21-23 (Juniors) in BC. TTCAN's bulletin will release more information when it becomes available.

For the BC provincial Juniors' team to compete in the 2025 National Junior Championships, BCTTA will have two preliminary challenges for pre-selected team members. There are three team categories: U19 Boys and Girls, U15 Boys and Girls, and U13 Boys and Girls. TTCAN's bulletin will announce all single events when they are available. Please reserve the following dates and read the rules and eligibility. BCTTA reserves the right to alternate the selection dates and amendments when necessary.

Eligibility and Rule:

Athletes must be:

- (a) Either Canadian citizens or Canadian permanent residents. If an athlete is in PR status, he/she must approve his/her residency in BC one month before the first Challenge Tournament. He/she is the first time for the Juniors' team selection, he/she has to have PR or citizenship documents submitted when registering his/her participation.**
- (b) Be members of BCTTA in good standing in the current year of 2024 Sept 1st to 2025 Aug 31st—membership fee: \$40.00/year.**
- (c) U19 Born in 2006 or later; U15 born in 2010 or later, U13 born in 2012 or later.**
- (d) All eligible athletes and parents must be aware that they will follow BCTTA's Junior Team's rules and conditions if he/she will be selected for the 2025 BC Junior Team and sign the agreement.**
- (e) BCTTA has the right to invite any athletes on the TTCAN's national senior or junior team list who have participated in international events to be team members.**
- (f) BCTTA has the right to choose the third and the fourth team members after three challenges.**
- (g) BCTTA has the right to decide on an alternate team athlete or replacement if the selected team athlete has an injury or other reason.**
- (h) Coaching and video recording are prohibited during the two challenges. Violations will be sanctioned.**
- (i) BCTTA will award the top two qualified Team members after 3 challenges in each age category: No charge to the registration fees of the team and single events and uniforms. Cash award: Team Gold \$100/each Silver \$75/each, Bronze \$50/each, And a 30% discount on the training camp costs. BCTTA will award the third and fourth qualified team**



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members free of charge the team event registration fees and uniforms. And a 15% discount on the training camp costs. To attend the Training camp is mandatory. Only three absent sessions will be allowed with a doctor's note or school's note.

Venue: Bridgeport Sports Club 11660 Bridgeport Rd. Richmond. B.C.

Entry fees: \$55.00 for each challenge (includes admin and rating fees)

Deadline: The **First Challenge: Jan 26, 2025, Sunday 5 pm. The second challenge: Feb 25, Sunday 5 pm**

Payment: E-transfer funds to: bcttatournament@gmail.com

Playing format: Best of 5 to 11 points. If the entries of each age category are less than 5, only one round-robin will be played. If the entries of each age category are less than 2, the players will be combined in another age category, but the result will be awarded to his/her age category. Winning points: 1st – 70; 2nd – 54, 3rd – 40; 4th - 28; 5th – 18; 6th – 10; 7th – 4; 8th -- 0. The top 6 players who won the most points after 2 Challenges will be pre-qualified for the BC Juniors' team selection with training camps. There will be a final challenge tournament in May to finalize the team members of each age category. The top two players with the most points have three challenges and are qualified. BCTTA has the right to select the remaining team (individual) members. More details will be released if they are ready.

For elite athletes unable to attend the training camp, if they live beyond greater Vancouver or outside Canada or compete in international tournaments or other special circumstances, BCTTA has the right to decide if they are qualified.
