Tournament Officials Per Diem Policy

Tournament Officials Per Diem Policy

This is the basic policy for the referees and umpires' per diem at the local tournaments:

1. Referee per day \$150, 10 to 12 hours with a free lunch.
Duties: View the prospectus, make corrections, check the venue setup, Do the draw, solve issues, and make decisions during the tournament, and write a report. Parking tickets will be reimbursed
2. Deputy Referee per day \$125, 10 to 12 hours with a free lunch.
Duties: View the prospectus, make corrections, check the venue setup, Check the draw, assist the referee, solve issues, and make decisions during the tournament. Parking tickets will be reimbursed.
3. Umpires: PU Level 6 hours or more have a free lunch.
\$8 per hour with a minimum of 6 hours per shift. Parking tickets will be reimbursed.
4. Umpires: Club Level 6 hours or more have a free lunch.
\$5 per hour with a minimum of 6 hours per shift. Parking tickets will be reimbursed.
5. Contral desk person: \$150 per day, 10-12 hours with a free lunch.
Duties: Check all entries, ensure all players are competing in the registered event. Get all matches running, enter all matches' results, report to the referee and deputy referee if there is any problem.

NOTE: Each post's per diem rate and duties are subject to change by the board's approval.
