- Single Events: Each provincial or territorial association may enter an unlimited number of eligible athletes in individual events. If entries exceed capacity, ATTA will prioritize athletes with higher Ratings until capacity is reached.
- In Junior singles, players may compete in their own age category and one higher age category. Both categories must include their own age group.
- Junior players may participate in only one team event in any age category for which they are eligible.
- Players may enter a maximum of two singles events in total, including both Junior and Open Singles.
- Only entries made by the member provincial/territorial associations will be accepted.

11. ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

To represent a P/T member association, a competitor must be:

- A member in good standing of a provincial/territorial association which is in good standing with Table Tennis Canada.
- Competitors must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents may participate in team event. New players must provide proof of status. Eligibility will be verified before the draw.
- Competitors who are not Canadian citizens or permanent residents may register for the Junior and Open Singles events.
- Players who have lived in multiple provinces or territories will represent the province or territory where they are listed on the rating list at the entry deadline.
- Players who have changed residence within six months before the Championships will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- Players without a Canadian rating, whether inactive or new, may be nominated by their provincial or territorial member association.

12. ENTRY PROCESS / DEADLINES

Registration opens on April 1, 2026. Details about the entry process will be posted on the ATTA website. Entry forms will be emailed to P/T associations. The registration deadline for P/T associations is May 11, 2026. Entries will be confirmed on the ATTA website by May 15, 2026.



13. DRAW FORMAT and SEEDING

- The draw format will be determined by the number of entries received.
- The Competition Manager may cancel an event if there are not enough entries. A minimum of four players is required to hold the event.
- In Junior singles, the top two players from each Round Robin group advance to the championship stage. After group play, a single knockout format follow.
- In Men's and Women's singles, the top two players from each Round Robin group advance to the championship stage. All other players automatically enter the Consolation Singles, which uses a single knockout format. Players in the consolation bracket do not advance to the championship stage.
- The Competition Manager reserves the right to modify the format of play at his/her discretion to ensure the best interests of the competition.
- The draw will take place on Wednesday, **May 20, 2026, at 6:30 pm MST**.
- The latest rating list as of May 7th, 2026, shall be used for seeding whenever possible.
- Players from the same provincial or territorial association should not meet in preliminary round robin groups whenever possible.
- There will be **no** separation by association in the knockouts.

Team Events:

- Each Member Provincial or Territorial Association in good standing with Table Tennis Canada is eligible to participate.
- Each Association may enter one team per age category for each gender. Players may only participate on one age-category team for which they are eligible.
- The Team format will follow the Corbillon style: two singles, one doubles, and two additional singles matches. Each team match will be decided by the best of five matches.
- Each Team may be composed of 2, 3 or 4 players.
- Players from different provinces/territories may not form a combined team.

15. ENTRY FEES

- Singles: \$50 per event (Maximum 2 single events per player)
- Teams: \$225 per Team • All entry fees include Rating and administrative fees.

16. REGULATIONS

All applicable TTCAN and ITTF regulations will be observed. In the event of uncertainty, the Tournament Referee and the ATTA Technical Director will interpret and apply the rules.
