Please inform the coaches from your association:

The TTCAN Coaching Committee proposed to the TTCAN Board last year certain requirements for coaches at the Canadian Championships. This included a level of certification (NCCP) as well as a “Safe Sport” requirement.

The Board decided that ALL coaches who will be coaching at the Canadian Championships must have completed the CAC’s “Safe Sport” online module. This is a requirement for the 2026 Canadian Championships in Winnipeg. All coaches wishing to coach at the Championships must have successfully completed the Safe Sport module.

Regarding the NCCP requirement, the Board decided that this aspect is left to each provincial/territorial association to decide if they wish to have a specific NCCP level of certification for the coaches from their province/territory who are funded or selected by the P/T association. It is up to each P/T association to decide.

PROCEDURES TO ACCESS THE “SAFE SPORT” MODULE:

- First step: log in to the CAC the Locker (<https://thelocker.coach.ca/Account/Login?ReturnUrl=%2F>). If the coach does not have the NCCP number, it is free of charge to get one using the link provided.
- Second Step: click the tab “eLearning”
- Third Step: select “Safe Sport Training” (free of charge)
- Fourth Step: select: “Sport”; then select the sport on the drop-down menu: “Table Tennis”; then select the options that apply.
- Fifth Step: start and complete the module.
- Last step: Print the confirmation and keep with you in Winnipeg.
