1. There are 4 team divisions. Each team consists of 2 players (no gender restriction). Each team's (2 players) combined rating should not exceed U3600, U1900, or U1100 except Open Team. Team events are non-sanctioned with limited teams. No membership is required. First come, first served.

2. Team events are best of 3 to 11 points from the round-robin to the finals.

4) U1550 -- \$40 5) U1250 -- \$40 6) U950 -- \$30 7) U650 -- \$30
8) U350 -- \$25 9) Age 35+ -- \$40 10) Age 60+ -- \$25

NOTE:

- Each player must register the same recorded name as his/her on the TTCAN rating system. Seeding will be based on TTCAN Sept Ranking.
- Singles events are sanctioned. Membership is required.**
- A USA player must report his/her US rating points.
- Each player can register for only one event if these events are scheduled at the same time.
- Cancellation must be submitted by email to bcttatournament@gmail.com before Sept 21at 3 pm, and A \$20 administration fee will be applied. No refund will be allowed if the cancellation is after Sept 21.
- Cash awards are subject to change depending on the number of entries.
- The tournament committee reserves the right to combine or cancel the event if there are fewer than 4 entries.
- The tournament committee reserves the right to remove any player if they are overrated at their registered event at any time.
- Each player is responsible for their practice ball.

The Tournament Committee has the right to forfeit prize money if players do not play the semi-finals and finals matches.

*In all other events semi-finals and finals winners will receive trophies, medals, and gifts depending on the sponsorships

Eligibility

Open to all genders. The tournament committee will assess non-rated players during the matches. The committee may remove a player from the registered event if they are overrated at any time.

Format

- Each team division will have a preliminary round-robin followed by knockout. 2 teams will advance. The consolation round might play if there is enough scheduling.
- **Team format: 2 singles and 1 Doubles (A v Y; B v X; AB v XY). All matches are best 2 of 3, and each game is best 2 of 3 to 11 points.**
- The single event shall have a preliminary round-robin followed by a knockout. The round-robin matches might play best 2 of 3 each game to 11 points, depending on the number of entries, followed by knockout best 3 of 5 games.

Rules

- **Current ITTF Laws of Table Tennis will be in effect.**
- All rackets must be one side black and one side of any other color with ITTF-approved coverings.
- Tie breaks in round robins will be decided by the score of matches, games, and points, only of those players involved in the tie.
- Only shorts and T-shirts are allowed to be worn during matches unless consent is given by the tournament referees. **The color of the playing shirt must not be white.**
- **Non-marking shoes must be worn in the gym, and street shoes are not allowed.**
- Players need to bring their own rackets and practice balls.

Umpiring

All players must volunteer to umpire all matches. Umpires will be provided at semi-finals and finals.
